THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH HAS HAS RELEASED THE 'BOIL WATER' NOTICE ISSUED ON 5/6/2019 8:54:59 AM BY RAYMOND ARNOLD FOR THE PORTION OF THE SYSTEM INCLUDING LEDRICK CIRCLE, FREDRICK LANE, SNUGGS CIRCLE, BAKER LANE, DICKENS LANE, NORTHSIDE DRIVE AND LEONA LANE, AFFECTING ABOUT 90 CUSTOMERS. THIS ORDER WAS ISSUED AS A PRECAUTIONARY MEASURE BECAUSE OF THE POSSIBILITY THAT CONTAMINATED WATER MAY HAVE ENTERED THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AS A RESULT OF COMPLETE LOSS IN NORMAL SYSTEM PRESSURE.

BACTERIOLOGICAL SAMPLES TAKEN ON MONDAY, MAY 6, 2019 AND TUESDAY, MAY 7, 2019 WERE FOUND TO BE 'SAFE' AND A SATISFACTORY DISINFECTANT LEVEL HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED THROUGHOUT THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM. THE WATER IS THEREFORE CONSIDERED 'SAFE' FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION AND THE 'BOIL WATER' NOTICE IS HEREBY LIFTED.

THE BOIL WATER ORDER WAS DUE TO FIRE HYDRANT REPAIR/BREAK.
